**COMPLAINT OF MY UNCONSTITUTIONAL EXCLUSION AND
MARGINALISATION FROM IMPORTANT COMMITTEE
DELIBERATIONS, BASELESS ALLEGATIONS AND DEMAND FOR
ADHERENCE TO THE LAW**

Mr Chairman I find it very important at this point to write to you officially in the light of your continued marginalization, my unconstitutional exclusion from important Committee deliberations and the incessant allegation against me by other members of the Electoral Committee and the members of the Branch against the Electoral Committee.

Members of this Committee have directly and indirectly leveled various allegations against me, the most recent being that I leaked the Branch attendance to the Mr Abdulsalam's team. I took my time to look and find the said attendance published by the said Mr Abdulsalam's team and I discovered that it is a Certified True Copy that could only have been issued by the Branch Exco, while the one in our possession is not a CTC. Clearly even on the face of it, it is not the same document and I could not have leaked what I do not have.

Since the inauguration of this Committee, I have deliberately severed ties to people that I consider my friends because of the delicate position that I now hold, not because I cannot trust myself to do what is right but because I must also be seen to be doing so.

I have kept quiet for this long not because I am unaware of what is going on or because I am afraid to speak. I have kept quiet and put my head down to do the job and get it over with but that now seems impossible.

The hypocritical and unconstitutional manner the members of this Committee have acted is rather disturbing. You all accuse me of leaking information, did I also leak the private message Mrs Nnenna Okoli Ezike sent to you Mr Chairman threatening to resign if you do not disqualify Mr Abdulsalam and you acceding to her request?

Is it constitutional to open another Electoral Committee Platform excluding me from it and important deliberations, thereby reconstituting the electoral Committee as a four man Committee instead of the five man Committee that the law provides for?

Did I also leak the disqualification of Mr Abdulsalam that you people concluded without me on the platform and later brought to the meeting and ask that I be heard first?

Did I also leak that names were forwarded to Mrs Magdaline Laya in the dead of the night to be added to the list including a name (Ehihiator Vivian Chinyere) that has not appeared anywhere else prior except the list of eligible voters?

If I intended to destroy or disrupt the work of this Committee, do you not think that leaking the fact that you opened a different whatsapp platform will make a more sensational story? Particularly in the heat of what is going on now.

I may be everything but I am not a fool, neither am I a child. Enough of the hypocrisy please.

In regards to the letter addressed to the Committee by Mr. Godday Owobu on 23rd May, 2026, wherein he alleged that 11 names of unqualified voters were added to the list of eligible voters, while scores of eligible voters were maliciously omitted, I have verified the attendance records and found these allegations to be true. Those 11 individuals are indeed not eligible and many qualified voters are still not on the list. Again Mr Chairman, among the 5 new names that I was assigned to verify, one Irivbogbe Bobby Aidonoje has also never attended any meeting from April, 2025 to April, 2026. Situations like these compromises the integrity of this election and I have a reputation to protect.

Mr Chairman regarding the 13 months issue, I have made my position clear particularly to the Committee Secretary that the May, 2026 meeting must be used and the May, 2025 must be struck off. The only justification for using the May 2025 Meeting would have been that the May, 2026 meeting will hold too close to the

election and will not allow the Committee the 14 days required for the publication of the final list. Now that this problem has been mitigated by holding the said meeting earlier, then we must put it into consideration.

The Committee Secretary's argument that May, 2025 meeting must count because the Branch Secretary has already forwarded the Attendance from April, 2025 – April, 2026 is a non-issue as the May, 2026 meeting can also be sent having just held as per the provision of Section 15(2a) of the Bye laws which provides that the Branch Secretary shall within 48 hours after meeting forward the attendance register to the Vice President under whose purview the Branch falls.

The Branch Secretary's action or inaction should not affect the work of this Committee and like I stated earlier, our integrity is at stake.

Commonsensibly, how do we explain not using the May, 2026 meeting having held well over the time that still allows us time to publish a final list and within the time prescribed the law that is; **12 months preceding election**? Would you also not suspect foul play if you were in the gallery watching?

For the sake of posterity, my integrity, and my values, I hereby call on you Mr Chairman to do the needful by immediately removing the 11 ineligible individuals from the list and urgently add the qualified members who were omitted.

I know I am only assigned roles just so I do not suspect anything or complain of not being involved and none of my works are used without verification by the other "superior and faultless" Committee members, as such I urge you Mr Chairman to verify these names yourself and do what is right.

I have received several calls and complaints that threaten my reputation and it is my sincere hope that we choose to do the right thing. However, if you do decide otherwise I will exercise my right to not be a part of such act.
